TAZEWELL TROLLEY

The trolley carried passengers back and forth from the Tazewell Train Station to Main Street in Tazewell. Streetcar service ran from 1892 through 1933. Early service was by horse drawn car. In 1904, it was replaced with an electric street car. Tazewell was known as the smallest town in America with an electric trolley. Tazewell was named Jeffersonville until February 29, 1892.
